Ladies Social Golf League Rules-2024

1. Each week we will have a shotgun start at 5:30. Please arrive by 5:15 to make sure you are prepared to start golf play at 5:30.
2. Please sign up each week on Facebook, if possible, at least 24 hours prior to the day. If you do forget to sign up you will still be allowed to play. We just ask for prior sign up to aid the board in getting teams set up for play.
3. Each week, the score cards will be at the bar with the game rules attached, the hole you will be starting on and the team you will be playing with.
4. When playing a scrambler, you have a club length from the 'best ball' to place your ball. If the 'best ball' is in the sand, you must place your ball in the sand. If the 'best ball' is in the rough, your ball must be placed in the rough etc.
5. Game Rules
 - a. If you are scheduled as a "B" team on a hole, please let the "A" team tee off first.
 - b. Max 10's – if your team is hitting shot number 7 and not onto the green after this shot, please take your ball and put it on the front of the green to putt. You then get three putts to try and make it (depending on the game being played). Pick up ball after MAX of 10.
 - c. Gimme putts - from 3 ft and in (you can lay your putter down and if your ball is inside the leather you're good, no need to putt). You do add one stroke to your score for the gimme putt.
 - d. If you or your partner lose a ball, or hit into the water, drop where you 'think' or your 'best guess' between your group and proceed from there with the 2 additional stroke penalty (one stroke for dropping a new ball and one stroke for hitting the next shot).
6. Place your scorecards in the basket located on the bench in the Ladies Locker room in the basement immediately following your round in order to receive eligible points for that week.
7. In the event of questionable golf weather, the board will decide by 4:30 and let everyone know if league is cancelled via Facebook (by text for those without facebook).
8. All attempted hits of the ball are to be counted.
9. Please play READY golf, this will help speed up play. Do your best to keep the game moving.

Don't be afraid to ask questions if you are uncertain about something.

Most important – HAVE FUN!

REQUEST from LCC grounds crew and main board:

Please respect the golf course . . .

- PLEASE USE CART PATHS AT ALL TIMES! Examples: Do NOT cut through grass going from 3 to 4, stay on gravel path and go past men's tee box. Do NOT cut across hole 7 fairway, through 6 to get to 8 tee box – go around on path.
- Always keep golf cart 30 feet from greens.
- Use seed/sand on your divots in fairways.
- Fix your divots on greens.
